The City of Huntsville, Alabama is issuing a Request for Proposal (RFP) informing the public that 501(c)3 non-profit organizations may submit proposals for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding of Public Facilities for Program Year 2024 from Monday, March 18, 2024, to Monday, April 1, 2024 at 5:00 p.m.

Responses to the RFP must be submitted online through the following link: <https://portal.neighborlysoftware.com/HUNTSVILLEAL/Participant>. The application link will be available for access beginning on Monday, March 18, 2024.

The City of Huntsville, Alabama receives funding for Public Facilities activities through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). The City of Huntsville's Public Facilities Program helps support infrastructure and facility projects for communities. Funds may be used for acquisition, construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, or installation of public improvements or facilities. Examples of eligible projects include improvements, repairs, or expansions community centers and facilities. Funds are limited to projects that, if implemented, meet a CDBG National Objective (benefit to low- and moderate-income persons, prevention and elimination of slums and blight, and urgent need) and meet the Priority Need and Goal identified in the 2020-2024 City of Huntsville Consolidated Plan, as amended, that is available on the City's website at <https://www.huntsvilleal.gov/residents/neighborhoods/community-development-public-notice-and-reports/>.
