KEMET BLACK POETS. Hi Everyone, Since April is the month that honors Poetry, let us consider the works of Black Poets. BLACK POETS' work provides rich insights, brilliant writing, and essential stories. Their poems inspire us to reflect, resist, and understand Black history. Let's meet a few of the most notable as well as lesser known Black Poets. WHAT IS POETRY? Poetry is not fiction or nonfiction but it is its own genre that focuses on rhythm and a certain number of syllables, lines, or stanzas. Poetry is a type of literature that conveys a thought, describes a scene or tells a story. Poems can be structured or they can be freeform. WHO ARE THE POETS? Black Poets are known to speak to us from their hearts, their experiences, their communities, and the world around them. They often speak words that inspire us, that causes us to feel and reflect. Some well-known poets are Langston Hughes, Gwendolyn Brooks, June Jordan, Maya Angelou, Phillis Wheatley, Amanda Gorman, Nikki Giovanni, Sonia Sanchez, Paul Lawrence Dunbar, Reginald Dwayne Betts, Countee Cullen, Arela Rodney, Daniela Gonyoe, and Pe'Tehn Raighn-Kem Jackson. And in 2023, Sharmont Influence-Little was named New Haven, Connecticut's first-ever poet laureate at the Elm City Lit Festival. NOTABLE BLACK POETS - LET'S SNAP IT UP!! Phillis Wheatley She was the first African American to write a book. The Wheatley family taught her to read and write English, and encouraged her to write poetry. Her book of poetry was published in 1773. It was called Poems on Various Subjects, Religious and Moral. This book made Phillis famous in England and the thirteen colonies. In 1775, Phillis wrote a poem for George Washington, who praised her work. It was titled, To His Excellency, General Washington. Amanda S. C. Gorman She is an American poet and activist. Her work focuses on issues of oppression, feminism, race, and marginalization, as well as the African diaspora. She was the first person to be named National Youth Poet Laureate. She read her poem "The Hill We Climb" at the inauguration of Joe Biden on January 20, 2021. She told book critic Ron Charles, "My hope is that my poem will represent a moment of unity for our country" and "with my words, I'll be able to speak to a new chapter and era for our nation." Nikki Giovanni She is a world-renowned poet, is known for being both outspoken and honest. Her work has been viewed as controversial, lyrical, empowering, and personal. Her work includes poetry anthologies, poetry recordings, and nonfiction essays. Her poetry has been praised for its ability to capture the experiences and struggles of black Americans, and she has used her platform to advocate for social justice and equality. Her collections of poems about black consciousness include: Black Feeling, Black Talk, Black Judgement, and Re: Creation. Giovanni's experiences as a single mother also influenced her poetry. Spin a Soft Black Song, Ego-Tripping, and Vacation Time were collections of poems for children. Maya Angelou She was an American author, poet, and professor. She also worked as a journalist, actress, and civil rights activist, using her voice and platform to speak out against injustice and inequality. She was best known for her poetry and several books based on her life, especially I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings. Throughout her life, she published many other autobiographies and collections of poetry, as well as children's books. In 1993, Maya Angelou recited her poem "On the Pulse of Morning" at President Bill Clinton's inauguration. In 2011 President Barack Obama gave Angelou the Presidential Medal of Freedom. Langston Hughes He was an important figure of the Harlem Renaissance. This was a period of great creativity among African American artists. Hughes wrote about the joys and sorrows of ordinary Blacks. He is known especially for his poetry, which includes: The Dream Keeper and Other Poems and The Weary Blues. In addition to poetry, Hughes also wrote novels, plays, essays, short stories, and children's books. Through his poetry, plays, and stories, Hughes helped other black Americans to see themselves as part of a much bigger group of people.
