ABSENTEE VOTING DEADLINES

★ TUESDAY, AUGUST 18TH @ 5PM

Last day for a voter to apply by mail for absentee ballot

★ THURSDAY, AUGUST 20TH @ 5PM

Last day to apply in person for an absentee ballot

★ MONDAY, AUGUST 24TH BY CLOSE OF BUSINESS

Last day for a voter to apply for an emergency absentee ballot

★ MONDAY, AUGUST 24TH BY CLOSE OF BUSINESS

Last day for a voter to hand-deliver an absentee ballot

★ MONDAY, AUGUST 24TH

Absentee ballots MUST be POSTMARKED

★ Tuesday, AUGUST 25TH BY NOON

Absentee ballots MUST be RECEIVED to be counted
