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Redstone Arsenal Environmental Program Public Comment Period – August 12, 2026-September 11, 2026 Proposed Corrective Measures at RSA-152

The U.S. Army Garrison at Redstone Arsenal is proposing to implement corrective measures at the RSA-152 groundwater unit located in the southwestern portion of Redstone Arsenal adjacent to the Tennessee River. The groundwater unit covers 889 acres and underlies eight surface media sites. Historically, activities at two of the surface media sites (RSA-032 and RSA-065) resulted in groundwater contamination where corrective measures will be conducted with the RSA-152 groundwater unit.

The Resource Conservation and Recovery Act facility investigations for RSA-032, RSA-065, and RSA-152 concluded that the Army's historical operations have resulted in releases of volatile organic compounds and explosive compounds to groundwater that pose unacceptable risks to human health receptors under a potable water use scenario.

The preferred corrective measures for groundwater consist of the following actions:

- Groundwater in situ enhanced bioremediation/in situ chemical reduction to treat the major chlorinated volatile organic compound plumes resulting from past storage activities at RSA-032 and RSA-065
- Groundwater monitoring of natural attenuation to address chlorinated volatile organic compounds and explosives in overburden and bedrock groundwater throughout RSA-152
- Land-use controls to prevent potable use of the groundwater and manage nonpotable groundwater use since the groundwater cannot be released for unrestricted use

The final corrective measures will be selected only after acceptance by the Alabama Department of Environmental Management, the public comment period has ended, and all comments have been reviewed and considered.
